NOTICE OF RACE (NOR)

1. Rules
 - 1.1. This event will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2013-2016, including US Sailing Prescriptions and by the rules of the International Laser Class Association.
 - 1.2. Rules may be changed by the sailing instructions.
2. Eligibility
 - 2.1. The White Bear Laser Invitational Regatta is open to all sailors in Laser Standard, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7, and Laser type rigs.
3. Registration
 - 3.1. Register in advance by mailing the completed registration form (attached to this NOR) with payment to the address listed on the form. Cash or checks only. Make checks payable to WBYC. Registration must be received by Friday, May 31 for the Lunch fee to be waived.
 - 3.2. Register on-site Sun., June 2 from 08:30 to 10:00.
4. Fees
 - 4.1. \$35 for Adults and \$25 for Juniors (Under 18). Includes snacks for breakfast and after sailing.
 - 4.2. \$5 for lunch (sandwiches). This fee is waived for sailors who pre-register (there is a free lunch!)
 - 4.3. \$5 Credit for US Sailing Members.
5. Schedule

6. Sailing Instructions
 - 6.1. Sailing instructions will be available during on-site registration and will be available on-line at www.wbycsail.org/regatta.html at least two days before the event.

7. Venue
 - 7.1. Address: Bellaire Beach, 2499 South Shore Blvd (Bellaire), White Bear Lake, MN 55110
8. Courses
 - 8.1. Primarily Windward/Leeward, but other courses may be used as indicated in the Sailing Instructions. Each race is to last approximately 20 minutes.
9. Classes
 - 9.1 Laser Standard, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7 and Laser type fleets will start and race together unless there are 5 or more Radials or 4.7's, in which case these fleets may have their own start.
10. Races Scheduled and Scoring
 - 10.1. 7 Races are scheduled and 1 race completed will constitute a regatta.
 - 10.2. Scoring will be per RRS Appendix A, Low-point system – each boat's series score will be the total of his/her race scores. If 5 or more races are completed, the worst score will be excluded.
11. Radio Communications
 - 11.1. A boat will neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to cellular telephones.
12. Awards
 - 12.1. Top 3 Places overall, Top Master, Top Junior, Top Female (and if 5 or more in a fleet – Top Radial and Top 4.7)
13. Water Bottles
 - 13.1. To protect our lake, we are taking a lesson from our collegiate sailing friends. Please bring non-disposable (re-usable) water bottles. Refills will be available.
14. Disclaimer of Liability
 - 14.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race.
 - 14.2. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
 - 14.3. Due to early season water temperature, appropriate clothing is recommended. Competitors will be required to wear Coast Guard Approved life jackets while on the water.

 - 15.1. Limited home hospitality housing will be available. Please contact Ryan Drake (see below).
